DELIVERY CONSIDERATIONS

☐ Plan for Container Placement:

 Delivery Driver Insight: Position the container centrally to improve workflow and reduce unnecessary movement or steps. This strategic placement ensures quick access to tools and materials, greatly increasing efficiency.

☐ Clear Access Path:

- **Tip:** Ensure a clear path for the delivery truck to back into place. Remove any obstructions that might block access.
- Choose a flat, solid surface like concrete or compacted gravel. Avoid steep slopes.
- Delivery Driver's Insight: Provide enough space for the truck to maneuver. Have cones on hand for traffic control if driver will be backing off a busy road.

MAXIMIZING SPACE

Efficient Packing:

- PRO TIP Uniform Boxes: As often as possible, use the <u>same-sized</u> boxes, bins, or totes for easier stacking. It is a small investment that makes a significant difference for keeping things organized!
- Labeling: Use colored tags or labels for easy identification of contents. Consider using different colors for different types of items (e.g., green for tools, blue for keepsakes).

■ Material Storage:

- Organization: Stack similar sized boxes and bins together. Store long items like lumber and pipes horizontally to maximize space.
- Accessibility: Arrange items based on frequency of use, with most-used items close to the door and at eye level.

A minute of organizing is an hour earned.

☐ Accessibility

• **PRO TIP — Maintain a Pathway:** If your Container won't be moving loaded, we suggest maintaining a clear <u>24" pathway down the center of the container</u> for easy access to items on both sides. Use Blue Painters Tape on the floor to mark off the "hallway" from the storage areas.

☐ Add Shelving

 Vertical Space: Install portable shelving units using special brackets that hang from the container's d-rings, optimizing vertical space and keeping the floor clear.

KEEPING CONTENTS SAFE

- PRO-TIP Security: Place a Masterlock 6850 padlock inside the "Lockbox" on a newer container the lockbox shields your padlock from being tampered with and it keeps it out of the elements. If you can't place a lock inside the lockbox, the second best place is on the right-hand door handle.
- **Moisture Prevention:** Only place dry items in storage & use moisture-absorbing tubs to prevent mold and mildew.
- Lights: Keep the area around the container well-lit to deter theft. A small magnetic solar light placed directly above the doors can make a big difference for security.

AVOIDING RIP-OFFS

- Delivery Fees: Avoid companies that don't disclose the container pickup fee in the initial quote, (surprising you with extra costs later).
- **Billing Cycle:** Some companies use a 28-day billing cycle to make the prices seem lower, but it actually costs you more over time.
- Reliable Delivery: Choose a company that uses its own skilled delivery drivers. Many container companies rely on sub-contractors for deliveries, which leads to problems like late deliveries or damage to your property.
